AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING AND AMENDING
CHAPTER 38 OF THE LANSING MUNICIPAL CODE
AND CREATING A NEW SECTION 38-223 WHICH
PROHIBITS PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
FRONT LAWNS OR PORCHES

Published in pamphlet form by authority of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lansing, Cook County, Illinois, this 21st day of June, 2011.

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WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lansing have determined that the parking of motor vehicles on lawns may create visual blight in the neighborhood; lower property values and cause mud to be deposited on village streets; and

WHEREAS, consequently, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that the prohibition of such parking is in the best interests of the Village of Lansing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lansing, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its Home Rule powers as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 38 of the Lansing Municipal Code is hereby modified and amended by the inclusion and addition of a new section, described as Section 38-223, entitled: "Parking of Motor Vehicles in Front Yards and Porches Prohibited", which Section shall provide as follows:

No person shall stand or park any motor vehicle as defined by Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 95 ½, entitled Illinois Vehicle Code, on any area of residential property other than the designated driveways and parking areas. No motor vehicle shall be parked on porches, or landscaped or grass areas. No such vehicles shall be parked on parkways, unless the parkway contains a paved area of sufficient size to permit the parking of a motor vehicle or vehicles thereon.

Any person violating the provisions of this Section shall be subject to the general penalty provisions contained in Section 1-23 of this Code.

Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
